Big Ten Track Coaches



JIM LAVERY, 39-year-old Indiana head coach of track and cross country, is saying farewell to coaching this season. After 17 years at Indiana, the last eight as head coach, he will become Associate Director of the School of Health, Physical Education and Recreation at Ohio University on July 1. His tenure since 1962 at Indiana has been climaxed by a steady rise to contending position and performances which have erased 23 of I. U.'s 36 records. A native of Calgary, Canada, Jim starred at Drake and ran on Canada's team in the 1952 Olympics.



BOB EHRHART, a native of Naperville and Wildcat track coach since 1960, has produced some great distance runners, although he won Big Ten titles as a vaulter at Northwestern in 1953 and 1954. His 1965 cross-country team won Northwestern its first Big Ten title and placed second in the NCAA, while two of his runners, Lee Assenheimer and Craig Boydston, in 1966 broke every school record for the mile and two mile. As an undergraduate Bob held the Thomas Coyne scholarship for academic and athletic achievement and was named Northwestern's "Athlete of the year" in 1954.



BOB EPSKAMP, for five years head coach at Miami University, was named Ohio State track coach in 1965 to succeed retired Larry Snyder. The Buckeyes have made a steady climb under Epskamp since a last place indoor finish in 1965. A 1952 graduate of Western Michigan, Epskamp, after Navy service, coached at Monroe (Michigan) High School and as assistant at Western Michigan before going to Miami in 1961. He developed strong teams at Miami and such individuals as Bob Shul, the 1964 Olympic 5000-meter champion, who was a world and American record holder.



CHARLES (RUT) WALTER is in his ninth year at Wisconsin, a period during which the Badgers won the indoor championship in 1962, 1965, 1967, and 1968 and the outdoor crown in 1964. At Northwestern, his alma mater, he won the Big Ten 440 title in 1928-1929-1930, the NCAA 440 in 1929, and ran anchor on the mile relay. He was on the Northwestern staff for 30 years, from 1952 to 1960 as head track coach. Walter was all-state in both basketball and track at Kokomo (Indiana) High School, winning three events in the state meet. In 1964 he was assistant coach of the U. S. Olympic team.



DAVE RANKIN has been Purdue's head track coach for 22 years, during which time he has developed many outstanding athletes. At Purdue Rankin was one of the school's most versatile athletes, football captain and All-American end, record-setting hurdler and All-American trackman. A 1939 and 1940 All-American, Rankin was named to the 1965 Sports Illustrated Silver Anniversary All-American football team. In track he was co-holder of the world record in 60-yard indoor low hurdles. He became a Marine fighter pilot in 1941 and flew 150 missions in the South Pacific, winning four air medals.



FRANCIS X. CRETZMEYER, University of Iowa track coach since 1948, is in his 21st year at the post. In the mid-30s he starred as an all-around track and field athlete at Iowa and still holds the scoring record for one season—144¼ points. He had his greatest coaching year in 1963 when his team shared the Big Ten indoor title and won the outdoor crown. His Hawkeyes broke three conference records, both indoor and outdoor. Iowans have won more than 100 titles in major meets. One team member was twice an Olympian and another made one Olympic team.



DAVID M. (DAVE) MARTIN, a former Michigan miler, is in his first season as head coach, succeeding Don Canham, who became Michigan's Director of Athletics. Martin inherited a solid tradition from his former mentor. In 19 years as Wolverine coach, Canham won 12 conference championships, finishing in the runner-up spot 16 times, and compiled a dual meet record of 52 wins, 13 losses, and two ties. Martin ran on teams that won three Big Ten indoor crowns, and one outdoor title. As Canham's assistant from 1963-68, Martin assisted in grooming two more championship teams.



FRANCIS S. DITTRICH is in his 11th season as Michigan State head coach. His 1965 squad won the conference outdoor championship and his 1966 teams won both indoor and outdoor Big Ten titles. A three-letter man in track and captain of the 1936 Spartan squad, Dittrich served 20 years as assistant to Karl Schlademan before succeeding him in 1958. His cross country teams won five Big Ten, three IC4A and two NCAA championships before he relinquished those duties in 1968. Nineteen of his athletes have captured a total of 38 individual Big Ten titles and one indoor NCAA crown. During World War II he captained an LCI in the Pacific.



ROY GRIAK, a 1949 Minnesota graduate who lettered in both track and cross-country, is in his sixth season as Gopher head coach. Before returning to Minnesota in 1963, his St. Louis Park High School squads won three state championships. His 1965 Minnesota team produced a pair of champions in shotputter Tom Barnes and two-miler Norris Peterson, the latter leading a rare 1-2-3 sweep for the Gophers. His 1968 team won conference outdoor championship, first outdoor title in history for Minnesota. Griak's 1964 cross country squad brought Minnesota its first Big Ten championship in 50 years, and his 1967 and 1968 teams placed second.



ROBERT C. WRIGHT, now in his fourth season as Illinois track coach, has led a resurgence of Illini track fortunes to the point where his team is on the verge of becoming a conference track power once again. A veteran of 29 years of high school coaching, his teams at Oak Park-River Forest won state title, two seconds, three thirds, a fourth and two fifths. A 1936 Illinois graduate, Wright played end and halfback on the football squad and ran hurdles and relays in track. He placed third to world record holder Jesse Owens in the 1936 Big Ten 200-yard hurdles, being given the same time as Owens in a tight three-way finish.
