Mon. Jul. 6

Leave NEW YORK by Jet Flight in the evening, flying into:

FRANCE

Tue. Jul. 7

Arrive PARIS in the morning. You will be met at the airport and transferred to your hotel. Balance of the day at leisure.

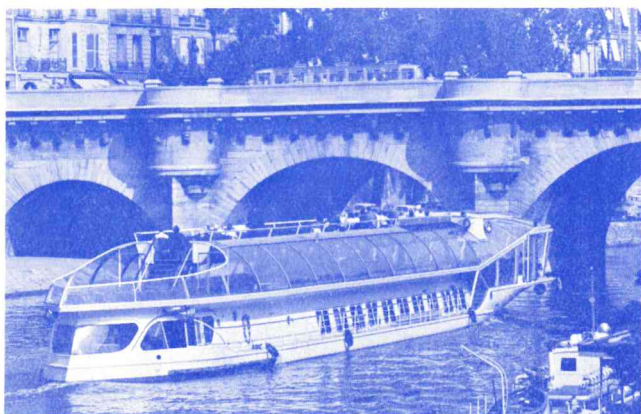
PARIS At leisure to attend the Track and Field Events.

Fri. Jul. 10

PARIS

Morning tour of Modern Paris, including the Opera, Place Vendome, the exquisite marble Madeleine Church, fashionable tree-lined Champs Elysees, Arch of Triumph impressive Napoleon's Tomb made of porphyry given by the Tsar of Russia, the famous Eiffel Tower, River Seine and the artists' quarter of Montmartre, and to the Basilica of the Sacred Heart, commanding a fine view over Paris.

Afternoon tour of historical Paris includes the Sainte Chapelle, colorful Tuilleries Gardens bounded by the Louvre, Place Concorde and palacial



Louvre Art Gallery, beautiful Luxembourg Gardens and Palace, the great Pantheon, picturesque Ile de la Cite and the lofty Cathedral of Notre Dame where Napoleon was crowned. Continue to the Place de la Bastille - former fortress prison - to the Left Bank with its many bookstalls, and through the Latin Quarter with the famous Sorbonne University.

Sat. Jul. 11

Leave PARIS driving via lovely scenery to Chartres for a visit to the superb Cathedral, then enter the lovely Chateaux Country where Renaissance France reached its elegant peak, to Chambord - largest of the Loire Castles. Continue to Azay-le-Rideau Castle, jutting over the Indre River, then to Langeais, a fine example of pre-Renaissance castle design. Continue via picturesque old mansions and fertile farming country to Tours, stopping in nearby MONTBAZON.





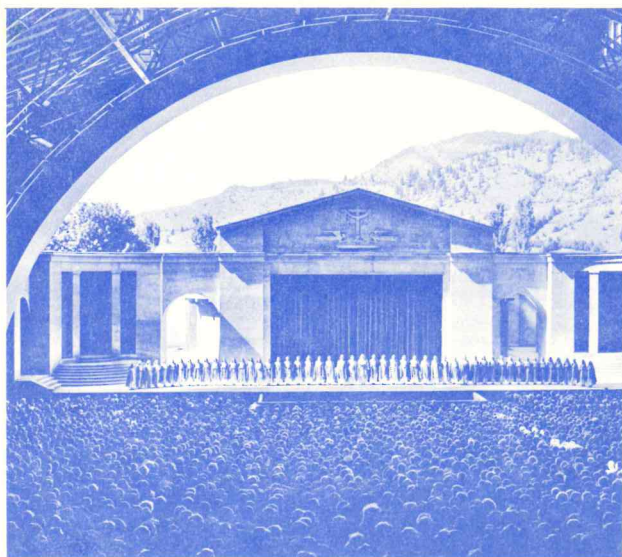
Sun. Jul. 12

MONTBAZON

Enjoy an excursion to Tour's interesting Cathedral, pass picturesque old mansions and visit the well-furnished Langeais Castle - a powerful medieval fortress protected by towers and a drawbridge. Continue to 14th century Saumur castle, dominating the Loire Valley. In the afternoon, drive through the Anjou wine district to visit the curious Abbey of Fontevrault with its fine monastic buildings and the only Romanesque kitchen left in France. Then, via the castle town of Chinon, to see Azay-le-Rideau castle jutting over the Indre River, and return to Montbazon.

Mon. Jul. 13

Leave MONTBAZON and drive to AVALLON.



Tue.Jul.14

Leave AVALLON and drive into:

GERMANY

to arrive STUTTGART.

Wed.Jul.15

and

Thu.Jul.16

STUTTGART At leisure to attend the Track and Field Events.



Fri.Jul.17

Leave STUTTGART and enjoy the drive to arrive MUNICH.

Sat.Jul.18

MUNICH

Morning sightseeing tour of the city, driving past Karolinerplatz with the Obelisk, to Koenigsplatz. Visit the Pinakothec and continue to the Academy of the Arts and the House of the Arts, then to the new city hall, visit the Hofbrauhaus, the German Museum and Karlplatz.

Afternoon drive through the city and its suburbs, past the National Opera House and Residence Theatre to Nympehnburg Palace - the summer residence of the former kings. This baroque palace is surrounded by some of the most beautiful park-like grounds imaginable, graced by water courses, lakes and a botanical garden.

Sun.Jul.19

MUNICH

Morning at leisure.

Leave MUNICH and drive through the verdant hills of Southern Bavaria to arrive in OBERAMMERGAU.

Mon. Jul. 20

OBERAMMERGAU

Today you will attend the "Passion Play", which is presented out of gratitude for the cessation of the Black Plague in 1634. It is presented every 10 years and all characters of the Play are portrayed by towns-people of this small Bavarian village. So sincere is their work that years of preparation are spent by each member of the cast during which time they study their part and live the life of the character they are to portray. The play fills the whole day, a day long to be remembered, a never -to-be-forgotten religious experience.

Tue. Jul. 21

Leave OBERAMMERGAU and return to Munich. Leave Munich by Plane, to arrive Hamburg. Change Planes, flying into:

FINLAND

to arrive HELSINKI and continue by Plane, into:

to arrive LENINGRAD.

Wed. Jul. 22

LENINGRAD

Morning tour of Leningrad includes the Nevsky Prospect thoroughfare, lined with palaces, churches and museums, the Neva River embankment, winding canals, Admiralty Building, Pushkin Drama Theater, Catherine I Monument, St. Isaac's Cathedral - a superb example of Imperial Russian architecture - the equestrian statue of Peter the Great, and the Fortress of Peter and Paul. Afternoon at leisure.



Thu. Jul. 23

and

LENINGRAD At leisure to attend the Track and Field Events.

Sat. Jul. 25

Leave LENINGRAD in the morning by Air to arrive MOSCOW.

Afternoon tour of Moscow includes its historical monuments, Bolshoi Theater which is the home of Russian ballet, the exterior of the Kremlin, Red Square, exterior of Lenin Mausoleum, St. Basil's many-domed cathedral, the great public buildings, GUM Department store, new skyscraper office and apartment complexes.

Sun. Jul. 26

MOSCOW

Morning tour of Moscow, featuring a visit inside the fortified walls of the Kremlin, including its magnificent palaces and cathedrals, alongside modern achievements in architecture. Visit Orushezhnaya Palace which is now a museum housing a priceless collection of Czarist regalia and ancient art works. Also see the huge Czar's Bell and Czar's Cannon as well as an outside view of the Supreme Soviet Building. Afternoon at leisure.

Mon. Jul. 27

Leave MOSCOW by morning plane, flying into the:

COST INCLUDES:

TRANSPORTATION : The following transportation is included in the cost: Economy Class Air transportation based on Group Inclusive Tour (G.I.T.) Fares as shown in the itinerary. The group must travel together, and return on Monday, June 27th.

HOTELS : Hotel accommodation will be provided throughout at first class hotels or similar and is based on two persons sharing a twin-bedded room with private bath where available.

MEALS : Table d'hote meals according to the custom of each country will be provided, whilst staying at hotels, as follows: Continental breakfast and a choice of either table d'hote lunch OR dinner in Paris, Montbazou, Avallon, Munich, Oberammergau. Elsewhere continental breakfast ONLY.

TIPS and TAXES : Tips to hotel attendants and government taxes on hotel services are included.

TRANSFERS : Transfers of the passenger and hand baggage from railroad stations, steamer piers or airports to hotels and vice versa, will be provided by private motorcoach.

SIGHTSEEING : Sightseeing programs as specified in the itinerary will be provided by private motorcoach and, unless otherwise stated, services of guide-lecturer and entrance fees are included.

ESCORT : An experienced Tour Escort will accompany the group from Paris around to Moscow.

BAGGAGE : Jet Economy Class passengers have a free allowance of 44 lbs. Maximum free baggage allowance on motorcoach is one normal-sized suitcase, per person. One small overnight bag may be brought, but must be carried by and remain in charge of its owner at all times. Excess baggage must either be stored or forwarded by express company at passenger's own expense. Baggage capacity of motor coaches is limited.

DEPOSIT : A deposit of \$200.00 per person is required to effect reservations and balance of payment is due six weeks before departure.

NOT INCLUDED : Passports, visas, airport or sea-port taxes, excess baggage charges, items not on table d'hote menus, admission tickets to Track and Field Events, laundry, liquors, mineral waters, meals not noted above, beverages with luncheons or dinners and expenses of a personal nature are not included.

CANCELLATIONS : NOTE: Refund of deposit will be made in full if you cancel your reservation up to six weeks prior to departure. After that time, full refund is made less any cancellation charges made by the carriers and hotels. Cancellation of air reservations is subject to a 25% cancellation fee by the airlines, if cancellation is made within 30 days of departure. This will amount to \$92.00 per person. There will be no refund for occasional missed meals or sightseeing tours.

NOTE: Tour cost based upon 19 members traveling together. Cost of arrangements will be adjusted if more or less than 19 members are traveling.

RESPONSIBILITY: Percival Tours Inc., and/or their agents, act only as agent for the passenger in regard to travel, whether by railroad, motor car, motor coach, boat or airplane, and assume no liability for injury, damage, loss, accident, delay or irregularity which may be occasioned either by reason of defect in any vehicle or for any reason whatsoever, or through the acts or default of any Company or person engaged in conveying the passenger or in carrying out the arrangements of the tour. They can accept no responsibility for losses or additional expenses due to delay or changes in air or other services, sickness, weather, strike, war, quarantine or other causes. All such losses or expenses will have to be borne by the passenger as tour rates provide for arrangements only for the time stated. The right is reserved to substitute hotels of similar category to those specified. The right is reserved to make minor changes in the itinerary, and the right is reserved to cancel the tour prior to departure, in which latter case, full refund will constitute full settlement by the passenger. No refund will be made for any unused portion of the tour unless arrangements are made prior to departure from the United States. The price of the tour is based on current tariffs and exchange rates, and is subject to adjustment in the event of any change in tariffs and exchange rates. The right is reserved to decline to accept or to retain any person as a member of this tour. Baggage is at owner's risk entirely. The issuance and acceptance of voucher or ticket shall be deemed to be consent to the above conditions.

The Airlines concerned and their agents and affiliates are not to be held responsible for any act, omission or event during the time passengers are not on board the aircraft. The passenger ticket in use by said airlines, when issued, shall constitute the sole contract between the airlines and the purchaser of these tickets and/or the passenger.
