## THE GOAL

The money goal for the Hayward Field restoration is \$600,000. This amount will cover the costs of razing the old stands and the construction of a NEW facility with approximately 5,200 covered seats. The construction will also provide space underneath the stands that can be finished into a mini-fieldhouse. This will allow track and baseball athletes to practice free from the chill and damp of uncooperative weather.

Planning for the facility left room for future development of seating and possible office space expansion for general university use.

Since State of Oregon funds are not available for the restoration, the critical needs will be met through a cooperative effort of the Oregon Track Club and the University of Oregon Development Fund. All of the gifts qualify as tax deductible contributions for the donor.

The plan is to raze the present stands immediately after the 1973 track season and to

have the new facility completed in time for the season of 1974.

Phase One of the Hayward Field Restoration drive is to solicit major gifts. Gifts between \$5,000 and \$25,000 will establish Heritage sections in the new grandstand. These will be finish line sections and each major gift will have an appropriate dedicatory plaque established for the section sponsored.

Major donors — giving between \$500 and \$1,000 — will be considered Hayward Field sponsors and a plaque, bearing the names of the sponsors, will be mounted in an appropriate place in the stadium. Sponsors may wish to purchase tickets from the Oregon Athletic Department for seating in this dedicated section.

Pledges and contributions at the major gift level are encouraged to be completed within two years.
