Park Hoop To Begin

Three leagues involving 20 teams will begin play this week in the Champaign Park District's industrial basketball program.

The Century and National leagues are comprised of eight teams each. They will play at 7 and 8 o'clock on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday nights at Edison and Franklin junior highs and the Bicentennial Gym at Centennial Park.

The American League's four teams will play at 7 and 8 on Wednesday nights at Franklin.

After the first round of play, the top four and bottom four teams of the Century and National leagues will be paired for a second round.

Century — American National Bank, Bundy Business Machines, Captain's Quarter, C-U Merchants, First National Bank, Stripe 3, Uncle John's, Metz Auction.

National — Allerton Implement, Callahan's Tavern, Edwards Golf, Gray's TV, Kraft Foods, Local Businessmen, Turnbull Inn AAMCO, Wood's.

American — Champaign National Bank, Cook's Transport, Rose Bowl, Stocks Inc.

Before Saturday's Class AA sectional at Princeton, coach Mike Sturrett of Champaign Central told Frank Reilly to run for the top three.

"He ran the race as if to say, 'The heck with the top three,'" Sturrett said. "That's the way he approached it, and that's good."

And that's how Reilly finished second to DeKalb junior Tom Wuchte, who was eighth in the state cross-country meet last year.

Reilly was Central's only qualifier for next Saturday's state meet at Peoria. Central was eighth with 163 points, only 11 behind the two teams that tied for fifth, East Moline and Mid-State Nine champion Peoria Central. Big 12 champ Danville was ninth and Rantoul 11th out of 15 teams.

The top five teams and top five individuals who are not

members of qualifying teams advance to the state meet in Classes A and AA.

"After the race, my immediate impression was that we made it," Sturrett said. "A lot of teams were having what you would call fifth-man problems."

Central made it to state in 1973 and 1973. Moline, rated No. 9 in the state, beat No. 7 DeKalb 14-127 for the team title.

Wuchte, who has lost only once this season, clocked 14:43 over the hilly 2.9-mile course. Reilly clocked 14:45.

Danville junior Mark Chase, who upset Reilly in the Bloomington District, finished 15th in 15:14.
