

Six M-S runners place in top 10

An impressive six Mahomet-Seymour runners finished in the top 10 in the Sept. 27 boys' cross country meet in Mahomet with Rantoul and Bloomington Central Catholic.

Junior runner Justin Sebens again led the Bulldogs, finishing in second place and posting a time of 16:41, just six seconds behind Rantoul's first-place finisher.

Following Sebens was third-place finisher Troy Pittman,

who posted a time of 17:25. Gabe Walder finished in fourth place with a time of 17:46, Jacob Mahaffey finished in sixth place with a time of 17:50, Jared Willard finished in seventh place with a time of 18:11, and Devin Lyons followed Willard at eighth place with a time of 18:19.

M-S won the meet with a team score of 22, followed by Rantoul's 43 and BCC's 70.
