

## Class 2A at Champaign <sup>69 25</sup> 2013

Danville's Johnny Leverenz was the individual winner, but Mahomet-Seymour dominated the boys' race at the UI Arboretum, placing five runners among the top 10. M-S had 25 points. Runner-up Central had 83.

Other area teams qualifying for the Decatur MacArthur Sectional: the fourth-place Vikings and sixth-place Centennial.

The M-S leaders were Alex Keeble (second), James Williams (third), William Wolf (fourth), Jackson Powell (sixth) and Ethan Russell (10th). M-S, ranked second in the state in Class 2A, has won three straight regional titles.

Urbana's Carter Huff placed ninth overall and moved on.

In the girls' race, M-S placed all seven of its runners among the top 16 and edged Mattoon 38-41 to win the Centennial Regional. M-S has won regional two of the last three years.

Mattoon had the top two runners, followed by M-S' Lauren Whitehouse. Central's Hannah Wright was fourth, followed by Danville's Mercedes Elliott (fifth) and M-S' Abigail Nielsen (sixth).

Area teams moving on besides M-S: fourth-place Central and sixth-place Danville.

Centennial moved three runners on: Rebecca Kaefting, Gabrielle Greaser and Brooke Miller. Urbana's Fiona Munro also advanced.
