# A PERFECT SCORE

## MSHS boys chase perfection at East Peoria Invitational

The Mahomet-Seymour boys cross-country team continued its dominance and maintained its No. 1 ranking by completing a perfect score at the 21-team East Peoria Invitational hosted by East Peoria High School at Illinois Central College in East Peoria on Saturday.

The Bulldogs placed runners in the top six individual spots in the 2.95-mile race for the perfect score of 15 points.

Andrew Walmer took first place with a time of 15:22.30.

and Gabe Pommier followed in second at 15:27.50.

Riley Fortune and Ryan Hodge placed third and fourth, respectively, each with a time of 15:35.30.

Brian Butcher took fifth place at 15:38.90, and Ben Crow captured sixth with a time of 15:47.90.

Evan Burge rounded out the top ten with a time of 16:04.50, and Joe Churm took 28th at 16:39.50.

Garret Williams placed in the top 30 with a time of 16:41.70.

The JV boys cross-country team also won its division of 132 competitors and placed four runners in the top six spots.

Mathias Powell won the JV race with a time of 16:45.80, and Bryson Keeble placed third at 16:53.70.

Kaelan Davis and Nate Douglas placed fourth and sixth, respectively, with times of 17:03.10 and 17:28.80.

David Wilcoski took 15th place with at a time of 18:14.80, and Gaven Williams rounded out the team's finishes with a 64th at 20:46.70.

On Oct. 8, the boys cross-country team is scheduled to enter the Metamora Runnin' Red Invitational, which the Bulldogs have won for the past four years.
