MSHS Boys' Cross Country

The MSHS cross country team placed second at the Peoria Notre Dame Invitational, losing only to Neuqua Valley, which is ranked #1 in AAA State and #3 in the Nation.

The Bulldogs took 8 of the 60 medals handed out at the Invitational. Andrew Walmer placed 12th, Riley Fortune placed 24th, Ryan Hodge placed 28th, Mathias Powell, 31st, Brian Butcher, 33rd, and Gabe Pommier 50th place in the varsity race.

Evan Burge won the 1st place medal in the open race, and Garret Williams placed 6th.

Elizabeth Sims took third place at 13:25 in the MSJHS varsity race Saturday. The Bulldogs placed 3rd overall, beaten by Tolono Unity and Shelbyville.
