■ **At St. Joseph.** **Garrett Dixon** of Monticello won the Spartan Classic with a time of 14 minutes, 40.30 seconds, pacing the Sages to the team title at the 26-school road race. **Aryan Lalwani** of Uni High took third in 15:15.48 as the Illineks placed third in the team race. **Cameron Woodard** (15:20.68, sixth place) led Unity to a fifth-place showing.

In girls' cross-country

■ **At East Peoria.** **Fran Hendrickson** of St. Thomas More placed third at the East Peoria Invitational with a time of 18 minutes, 11.3 seconds as the Sabers wound up 12th at the 18-team meet. **Elizabeth Sims** (18:26.9, fifth) and **Brisa McGrath** (18:40.5, eighth) helped Mahomet-Seymour to a second-place finish. **Chian Scott** led Urbana with a 10th-place finish (18:40.8) and **Shannon Tang** paced Champaign Central (20:07.8, 37th place).

■ **At St. Joseph.** **Alyssa McPike** of Monticello toured the Spartan Classic course in a top time of 17 minutes, 36.19 seconds, but Unity took home the team title at the 24-team meet. **Caroline Bachert** placed third in 17:53.27 to pace Unity, while **Cassidy Bagby's** fifth-place finish in 18:11.21 spearheaded the efforts for runner-up St. Joseph-Ogden. McPike's finish helped the Sages place third in the team standings.
