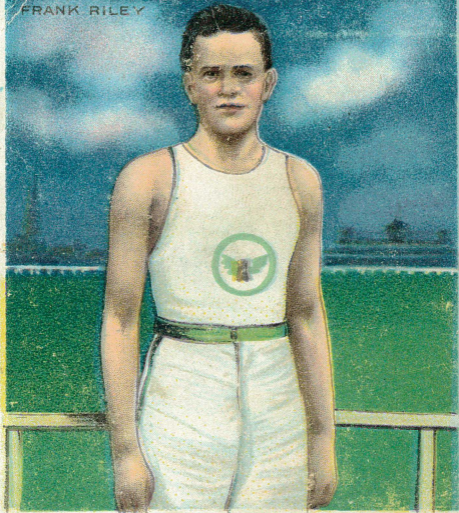


FRANK RILEY



FRANK RILEY, of the Irish-American Athletic Club, was a member of the American Olympic team of 1908 that competed in London. Riley ran third in the 1,500 meters run at the Olympic try-outs held at Franklin Field, Philadelphia, but did not place in the finals at London. At the Metropolitan A. A. U. Junior championships Riley won the mile title and later in the year ran a slashing race in the 880 yard Canadian championship, taking second place and forcing Emilo Lunghi to break the record. Riley is a prominent member of the Thirteenth Regiment A. A., and has competed successfully on their relay team.
