

H.E. GISSING



HARRY GISSING, of the New York Athletic Club, is one of the best middle distance runners in the world to-day. In 1908 Gissing won the Junior National A. A. U. half-mile championship, his time being 1 minute 56 4-5 seconds, and in the same year won the 1,000 yard indoor National A. A. U. championship. Gissing won the 880 yard Metropolitan championship in 1909, and also got second place in the Senior National championship held at Seattle, Washington, and at the indoor championships of 1909 and 1910 successfully defended his 1,000 yard title. Gissing is also very fast at the quarter mile, running in the New York A. C. relay team as anchor, where he has many times turned apparent defeat into victory.
