

HARRY JENSEN



HARRY JENSEN, of the Pastime Athletic Club, is at the present time the amateur "Marathon King" having competed in and won more long races than any other amateur marathoner. On February 8, 1909, Jensen came in second in a marathon held at the Clermont Rink, Brooklyn, and on February 12 ran third in the Brooklyn-Sea Gate marathon, held under the auspices of the Thirteenth Regiment A. A. On April 11, 1909, Jensen won the marathon held at Celtic Park, his time being 2 hours 48 minutes and 47 seconds. On May 29 Jensen ran second in the Flatbush Marathon, and he finished up his year by winning the Yonkers Marathon on November 27, in the fast time of 2 hours 46 minutes and 43 1-5 seconds.
