J. A. RUDDY, of the New York Athletic Club, has been competing in swimming events for over seventeen years. Ruddy won his first race at the age of 13. In 1898 and 1899 he won the 80 yard Metropolitan Championship, and since then swam on every championship relay team till 1908. Ruddy has also played on every championship Water Polo team from 1898 to the present time. At Cleveland, in 1902, Ruddy broke the American records from 20 yards to 110 yards, and also established new records for swimming with feet and knees tied, from 20 to 40 yards. Ruddy has accumulated about 540 prizes for swimming, water polo, running, shot putting, hammer-throwing and jumping.
