JAMES J. McENTEE is considered one of the best quarter-mile or short-distance runners in the United States. He is a leading competitor in prominent athletic meets of the Young Men's Christian Association and the National Guard in the eastern part of the country, and always carries off high honors, if not the highest, at these competitions. He made a quarter-mile in 53 seconds at the New York West Side Y. M. C. A. in 1906, breaking the record, and two years later won in the open Military Athletic League handicap. He has also had a prominent place among members of the New York Athletic Club.
