## JOHN FLANAGAN.

John Flanagan, of the Irish-Americắn Athletic Club, is one of the world's greatest hammer throwers. Flanagan has been in competition as a hammer thrower more than fifteen years. Before entering this branch of sport he wasquite speedy on the cinder path, running the 100 -yard dash in close to record time.

Flanagan won the world ${ }^{\circ}$ s championship at Paris in 1900, again at St. Louis in 1904, and at the London Olympiad in 1908, holding the Olympic record of $170 \mathrm{ft} .4 \frac{\mathrm{in} \text {. made in London. }}{\text {. }}$

Flanagan is a National and Metropolitan A. A. U. champion many times over, having won his first championship in 1897, and he has been winning both Metropolitan and National championships ever since.
