"My main regret is that I can only run seven of our runners at the state meet," Garrison said. "We have such a strong team that goes beyond just seven runners deep. They all sacrificed so much, and it is hard to know that only seven runners get the chance to represent the entire team."

Eleven different squad members have posted 3-mile times of less than 17 minutes this season for the state-ranked (No. 7) squad.
