

PLATT ADAMS

Platt Adams, of the New York Athletic Club, has made a specialty of the jumps. He was a member of the 1908 Olympic team and placed third in the standing high jump. Adams won the javelin throw at the Olympic tryouts at Philadelphia, Pa., in 1908, making a new American record, and also won the hop, step and jump. In the same year he won the National A. A. U. broad jump championship, the standing broad jump and the running hop, step and jump.

Besides his jumping ability Adams is very clever with the discus, having won the junior champion-

ship in 1907.
