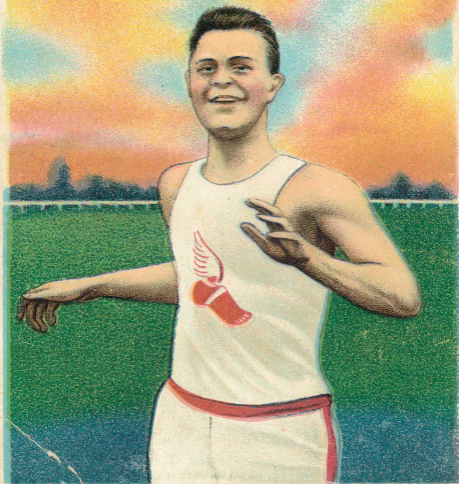


WALTER BURSCH



WALTER BURSCH, of the New York Athletic Club, is destined to be one of America's greatest hurdlers.

Bursch won the Metropolitan Junior A. A. U. 220 yard hurdle championship in 1908, and ran second in the Senior championships in 1909.

Bursch is a member of the Twenty-third Regiment, and at their fall games equalled the record for the 120 yard high hurdles.

At the Military Athletic League championships in 1909 Bursch won the 220 yard hurdle championship, running close to record time.
